2-Day Crisis Intervention Training (CIT)

Crisis Intervention Training provides participants with verbal tools to de-escalate situations prior to the crisis level, and the techniques to restrain an individual, as a last resort, who is physically acting out and is a danger to self or others. Upon successful completion of the 2-day course, participants are certified by the National Crisis Prevention Institute, Inc. Renewal certification training is required every 24 months to maintain certification.

Day 1: Instruction for verbal techniques to de-escalate a potential crisis situation. Instruction for disengagement. Also included is an overview of the warning signals and possible causes of undesirable behavior. Lecture and physical practice require attendees to engage and participate.

Day 2: **Requires prior approval from district special education administrator.** Instruction and practice of holding skills. These techniques require a two-person team on site. Holding is always considered the LAST RESORT after all verbal strategies have been exhausted. Non-Violent Crisis Intervention is legally recognized in California for special education students. **Individuals MUST BE injury free and physically able to participate in all activities.** Please wear comfortable clothing and close-toed, flat heeled shoes or tennis shoes.
