# **Summary of Key Issues**

The San Luis Obispo County Special Education Local Plan Area (SELPA), in partnership with Parents Helping Parents and the Community Advisory Committee, hosted a "Special Education Parent Institute" on September 20, 2025, at Loma Vista Community School. The event, titled "Partners in Progress," aimed to empower families, schools, and communities to support children with disabilities by providing opportunities to connect, network, and learn together.

The institute ran from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and featured a variety of workshop sessions and exhibitors. Special guests included Dr. Brescia as a welcoming speaker and representation from Assemblymember Addis' office, who hosted a Legislative Listening Session.

In total, there were over 100 people who participated in the event, with 15 exhibitors, which included Tri-Counties Regional Center, Department of Rehabilitation, First 5 SLO County, Central Coast Autism, ADHD Allies, and others.

The event also celebrated the 50th Anniversary of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), which was signed in 1975. Fifty years ago, this landmark legislation opened doors and transformed the lives of millions of children, ensuring their right to a free, appropriate public education. IDEA isn't just a law; it's a promise—a promise of equity, access, and inclusion for every student, regardless of their abilities.
